The Youth Club have also been contacted to see if they would be interested. Adults are encouraged to take part and information and paper will be available at the village coffee mornings (or use your own materials). DM
- 8.) There will be a duck race at 5pm and all proceeds will be divided amongst the winners. Ducks will be on sale before the event. SH and volunteers.
- 9.) BB has volunteered to make the Community 'centrepiece cake'.
- 10.) Display of photos and memories of previous Queen's celebrations AC, MM
- 11.) Community photo of all Residents attending, time to be confirmed. AP
- 12.) WU is arranging a classic vehicle exhibition of 12 cars, 2 tractors and 3 motorbikes
- 13.) It is hoped that the invitations will be available by 28th April at the Annual Assembly and the remainder distributed shortly after that.
