- Making teas and coffees
- Assisting our guests on how to use the toaster (!!)
- Clearing down breakfast and washing up the dishes
- Checking stock required and noting ready for ordering
- Setting up the breakfast room ready for the next day including vacuuming, and cleaning the loos
- Helping with checkout questions from guests or referring them if required
- Cleaning the public areas of the pub (Housekeeping will be doing all the rooms)
- Setting up the bar ready for opening at 12:00
- Being an all-round helpful person as part of your lovely team
